## **Innovative Systems and Products**

A building enclosure is generally defined as the part of the building which separates the interior and exterior. However, the reality is much more complex, with the building enclosure exposed to a wide range of interior and exterior loads and stresses, while needing to provide multi-faceted functions of structural and elemental support, air, moisture and temperature control, and durable interior and exterior finish. In addition, there are seemingly unlimited options for designing, detailing and constructing the building enclosure, including through utilization of a huge variety of systems and products. As such, it is an ongoing challenge to design and construct reliable, long-lasting, durable, energy efficient and cost effective building enclosures.

To address these ongoing challenges, the construction industry continuously re-assesses existing approaches to building envelope performance, while manufacturers often develop innovative new systems and products. In order to promote innovation and to provide information on new systems and products, BECOR is happy to present a half-day series of presentations which highlight some recent innovations.
