Collaborative Approach in Project Delivery

The recently completed Faculty of Health Sciences Building, University of Ottawa, is on target to achieve LEED Platinum and has been modelled to obtain a TEDI score of 37.1 kWh/m². This is the result of a carefully detailed and cutting edge exterior rainscreen envelope. The presentation will discuss the architects' perspective on the challenges faced by the design team.

Presenters

Will Prange, M. Arch., OAA, MRAIC:

Will is a senior principal with the Ottawa office of Architecture49 and a lead architect for the project. Early in his career, he performed many building audits and repair documents in a building forensics role. Through this effort he has learned how to detail a building and ensure it is constructible. The building science aspect allows him to have meaningful and often challenging discussions during design to eliminate envelope failure without unnecessary and costly envelope components. This all results in being able to push big design ideas to create meaningful projects but still be technically sound and within budget.

Marin Katov, Ph. D., Architect OAA, PMP:

Marin is a Senior Architect with Architecture49 and played a key role in the early design stages of the project applying his rich background in post-secondary education projects and campus planning. His keen interest in the building science aspects of the building envelope brought him back during the construction documentation phase to lead various facets of the project.
