Roof Restoration: Extending the Life of Your Roofing Asset

Roof restoration is the process of preserving an existing roofing asset by upgrading the waterproofing and flashings to extend the overall life and provide a new extended warranty. Restoration is often a safer, less disruptive and more cost effective option than full roof replacement.

This webinar will highlight the process of restoration, including: initial assessment and diagnostics, acceptable restoration candidates, benefits and limitations, restoration options available in the current marketplace, and local project profiles. We will include discussion of Restoration systems for Modified Bitumen, Single Ply, Built-Up Roofing and Metal Roofing systems. Local project profiles will include the CN Tower and Enercare Centre.
